



The first feedback was collected for the curriculum taught in the institute and the responses of the students have been presented in the bar diagram below.


1.According to you Curriculum and Syllabi of the Courses is.

The next question is about the coverage of syllabus in the institute. The responses collected from the students have been presented in the bar diagram below.






The average rating as depicted in the above diagram is 4.08, it reflects that the syllabus coverage in the classes are significantly high. Students are satisfied.

3. Course delivery by faculty members in the class






The ratings provided by the students for this section is 4.13. This indicates that the students are highly satisfied by the way the faculties are delivering lecture in the class room.

The next question is about usage of ICT in the teaching learning process. The responses present in the bar diagram below.


4. Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching




The use of the ICT by the faculty members has been rated little lower (3.89). This indicates that the faculty members are not using sufficient ICT tools for the class room teaching.

The next question is about the fairness of the evaluation process of the institute. The responses have been presented in the bar diagram below.









The rating of 4.03 as provided by the students indicates that they are highly satisfied regarding the timely performance of the assessment and evaluation process of the institute.


The next question is about timely announcement of the exam result. The responses of the students have presented in the bar diagram below.






The students are highly satisfied regarding the timely evaluation followed by the announcement of the result of the examinations; this is supported by their rating given as 4.16.

The next question is about the opportunity available for the students in the college.









This aspect is not able to fulfil the expectation of the students. Therefore, they have provided a low rating of 3.64.

The next question is about the student exchange and, internship and field visit opportunity for the students.








The students have given an average rating of 3.69. This indicates that the students are not satisfied with the opportunities available in the institute regarding the internship and student exchange programme.

The next question is about the learning opportunity from external sources.


 Opportunities for out of class room learning (guest lectures, seminars, workshop, value added programmes, conferences, competitions)
